On June 17, 2016 The Pine Hill Police Department and Camden County Prosecutor's Office Suburban Narcotics Task Force, with assistance from the Lower Camden County Regional Special Response Team executed a search warrant in the 100 building of the Mansions Apartments. The search warrant was the result of a month long joint investigation conducted by the Pine Hill Detective Bureau and the Task Force into the distribution of crack cocaine in the Mansions Apartment Complex and surrounding area.

Rasul H. Dunlap was taken into custody without incident in the Chalet Gardens Apartment complex as the search warrant was simultaneously executed at the Mansions apartment. Continued investigation determined Rasul Dunlap was utilizing the apartment in the 100 building of the Mansions Apartments to operate a controlled dangerous substance production facility. Investigation within the apartment led to the seizure of a quantity of suspected crack cocaine along with manufacturing materials including, digital scales, baggies, and other paraphernalia used to package crack cocaine for distribution. Upon his arrest, Rasul Dunlap was found to be in possession of a quantity of suspected crack cocaine packaged consistent with distribution.

While on location, officers arrested two additional individuals who were determined to be in the area of the 100 building for the purpose of purchasing illegal narcotics. Both were processed accordingly and released pending court appearances.

Pine Hill Police Bicycle Patrol Officers canvassed the Mansions community to meet with residents and provide information on how to report suspected illegal activity and contact information for drug addiction support services.
