On January 31, 2013 at approximately 11:12PM, Pine Hill Police Officers were dispatched to The Greens at Pine Hill Apartment Complex, located at 350 Blackwood Road, in the area of the 2600 building for a suspicious male knocking on the caller's front door. Upon arrival officers located a male matching the description provided and identified him as Dominique Walker, age 24 from the 1500 block of Thorn Street, Camden City NJ.

While speaking with Mr. Walker he admitted to knocking on a front door at the 2600 building. A warrant check resulted in his arrest for the following active warrants issued out of the Stratford Borough Municipal Court (\$1,000.00 full cash) and Camden City Municipal Court (\$130.00 full cash).

Continued investigation led the Officers to an apartment in the 2300 building of the complex. Upon arrival at the apartment officers spoke with the resident, during which the officers smelled the strong odor of burnt Marijuana coming from inside the apartment. During the subsequent investigation at the apartment the following items were seized; Seventy (70) black glassine bags containing Crack-Cocaine, Marijuana 50 grams or less, and drug paraphernalia. Dominique Walker was determined to be the owner of the narcotics and paraphernalia.

Bail Status: Remanded to Camden County Correctional Facility in default of \$38,000/% 10 bail.

A Drug Offender Restraining Order (DORO) was also issued preventing him from being in the Greens of Pine Hill.
