On May 9th, 2012 at approximately 2314 hours, Officers were dispatched to the 200 building of the Mansions Apartment Complex located at 220 W. Branch Avenue for a reported strong armed Robbery. Responding Officer's located the victim in the front of the apartment complex. The victim advised he provided an unknown unidentified male and two females with a ride from the Wawa Store located at 917 Erial Road in Pine Hill to the Mansions Apartments. The victim reported stopping in the complex to let the females out of the vehicle, at which time the male threatened him with bodily harm and physically took \$120 from his person. The suspect fled the area on foot and was last seen running to the rear of the 200 building. The victim provided a detailed description of the suspect and provided the same to investigating officers.

A perimeter was established and canine search of the immediate area was initiated. The canine track, subsequent search and investigation at the scene led to the positive identification and arrest of Timothy Bastone. Bastone was located at an apartment in the complex and physically resisted arrest when Officers attempted to take him into custody. He was ultimately taken into custody without injury to himself or investigating Officers. Bastone was charged with Robbery, Resisting Arrest and Obstruction of Justice and remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of \$62,500 bail.
