<p>On June 16th, 2012, three arrests were made for Driving While Intoxicated between the hours of 4:29pm and 11:58pm. Two arrests were the result of motor vehicle crashes, after which the driver's fled the scene.</p> <p>At 4:29pm Officers received the report of a motor vehicle crash on Erial Road at the intersection of Sitley Avenue. The caller reported a pick-up had left the roadway and struck a utility pole, causing the pole to break into two pieces. The truck fled the scene on Erial Road towards Clementon, but was stopped in the area of the intersection of Erial Road and Gibbsboro Road. The driver, John A. Shaffer, 55 years of age from Gibbsboro was arrested at the scene for DWI and possession of CDS. He was charged with DWI, leaving the scene of an accident, possession of Marijuana and related traffic offenses. He was also found to have active warrants out of the N. Wildwood Municipal Court. He was processed accordingly and released pending a scheduled court appearance.</p> <p>At 10:15pm Officers received the report of a motor vehicle crash on E. 4th Avenue. The caller reported a minivan left the roadway, struck a fence and fled on E. 4th Avenue to Erial Road with a flat tire. An Officer located the vehicle and the driver in the parking area of Lucky's Tavern on Erial Road in Pine Hill. Margaret Nilan, 64 years of age from Pine Hill was arrested at the scene for DWI. She was charged with DWI and leaving the scene of an accident. She was processed accordingly and released pending a scheduled court appearance.</p> <p>At 23:58pm a motor vehicle stop was conducted on Blackwood-Clementon Road for a moving violation. When the vehicle stopped, the driver exited and began aggressively approaching and screaming at the Officer. James Rodriguez, 41 years of age of Camden was taken into custody without incident. Rodriguez was charged with DWI, Obstruction and DWI while his driving privileges were suspended for a DWI conviction. He was processed and remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of \$3500.00 bail.</p>
