<p>On July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at approximately 2:00pm, Officers from the Pine Hill and Lindenwold Police Departments attempted to serve a warrant in the unit block of E. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Warrants had been issued by the Lindenwold Police Department for the arrest of Terrance L. Williams for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Robbery. As the initial responding Officers approached the residence, the suspect attempted to exit the residence, but saw the approaching Officers and ignored their commands to stop. Williams entered the residence and secured the door.</p> <p>The scene was secured by Pine Hill and assisting Officers from surrounding jurisdictions. Contact was made with a female in the residence and she exited a short time later. She was escorted safely from the scene by Officers. She was later found to have active warrants out of the Pine Hill Municipal Court.</p> <p>Numerous assisting agencies assisted in securing the area and notifying residents in the immediate vicinity to remain inside due to the nature of the incident. Critical Incident Negotiators attempted to contact Williams for several hours, but he refused to respond. Special Response Team members entered the residence, along with assisting k-9 Units and located Williams hiding in a small crawlspace under the residence. He was taken into custody after resisting arrest by SRT Officers. Williams was transported to a local hospital for medical treatment and cleared for incarceration.</p> <p>He was charged with 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Obstruction of the Administration of Law and 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Resisting Arrest. He was remanded to the Camden County Correction Facility in default of \$22,500 for the charges arising from this incident. Bail was set at \$100,000.00 for the Robbery warrant issued out of the Lindenwold Police Department. Heather Morocco, 21 years of age from Pine Hill was remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of \$550.00 bail.</p> <p>Assisting law enforcement agencies included; Zone 4 SRT, Gloucester Twp.
