On October 1, 2012 at approximately 0719 hours Pine Hill Officers were dispatched to 220 West Branch Avenue in the area of the 1400 building for the report of a pedestrian struck by a motor vehicle. Dispatch informed responding Officers the pedestrian had been struck a second time by the vehicle.

Upon arrival Officers located the victim, a 37 year old male lying on the ground. The victim was complaining of pain and had injuries to his leg. Investigation by responding Officers determined the victim had been struck by the vehicle approximately five times and had been operated by the victim's girlfriend, identified as Emerald Black. Several witnesses were present during the incident. Emerald Black was located in the complex and taken into custody without incident.
