On April 18th, 2013 at 6:30pm the Pine Hill Police Department, with the assistance of the Gloucester Twp. Police Department and Camden County Prosecutor’s Office HIDTA executed a search warrant in the 3700 building of the Tall Pines community in Pine Hill. The search warrant, and several arrest warrants were the result of a two month investigation into the distribution of Marijuana, Oxycodone narcotic pills and Methamphetamine involving several individuals in the Tall Pines Community. Members of the Lower Camden County Regional Special Response Team assisted in the execution of the search warrant in the 3700 building, and arrest warrants in the 1600 building and in the area of the 700 building.

Brian Morton was taken into custody at the 3700 building of Tall Pines. The subsequent search of his residence led to the seizure of Marijuana, 30mg Oxycodone pills, Methamphetamine, and a loaded revolver with additional ammunition. Stephanie Pangborn was also taken into custody at the 3700 building of Tall Pines and was found to be in possession of 30mg Oxycodone.

Christopher Douglas was taken into custody at the 1600 building of Tall Pines on a warrant issued for the distribution of a Schedule II Narcotic. Douglas was observed in the area of the 3700 building in a suspected narcotics transaction just prior to his arrest. Eric Zimmerman was arrested a short distance from the Tall Pines community and charged with loitering for the purpose of obtaining CDS. The subsequent search of Douglas’ residence led to the seizure of over 3.5 ounces of Marijuana packaged for distribution, over 100 30mg Oxycodone narcotic pills, and a loaded semi-automatic handgun.

Kareem Collins was taken into custody in the area of the 700 building on warrant issued for the distribution of a Schedule II Narcotic.

All suspects were taken into custody without injury to the Officers or suspects.

Bail Status: Remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of \$124,500/full cash bail
