On March 30th, 2013 at approximately 10:58am, Pine Hill Officers were on a foot patrol in the area of the 800 building of the Mansions Apartments, located at 220 W. Branch Avenue. As the Officers approached the building, they heard people verbally arguing inside of an apartment. As officers approached investigate the disturbance, an officer observed a male occupant throw an object out the rear door of the apartment. Officers retrieved the item and identified it as a quantity of Crack-Cocaine packaged for distribution in 17 packets. Further investigation at the scene led to the identification and arrest of the individual who threw the Crack Cocaine from the apartment. Leonard H. Green, of Camden City was also found to be in possession of 30mg Oxycodone without a prescription, a knife and CDS paraphernalia. He was remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of bail.

Pine Hill Charges: (2) counts for possession of oxycodone 30mg, possession of crack cocaine, possession with intent to distribute less than half ounce crack cocaine, unlawful possession of weapon, unlawful possession of weapon while distributing CDS and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Bail Status: Remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of \$82,500/full cash bail. A Drug Offender Restraining Order was also granted against Leonard Green, barring him from 220 W. Branch Avenue Pine Hill, NJ 08021
