On April 7th, 2013 at 12:15pm officers responded the 100 block of Estates Drive for an attempted Burglary. Alert residents in the area observed a female in the rear yard of a residence and immediately contacted the Police. The residents were able to provide a detailed description and name the female had given when they confronted her. Based on the description provided and the name of "Janine" given to the Officers by the alert residents, Officers located the suspect at a residence in the 1000 block of Turnersville Road. Janine Taunitas was identified and arrested for several active warrants for her arrest. During the initial burglary investigation, officers were dispatched to a second burglary in the unit block of Congress Drive.

Information obtained during the investigation of both the attempted burglary on Estates Drive and the Burglary on Congress Drive resulted in Taunitas being charged with Criminal Attempt Burglary, Burglary and Criminal Mischief. She was remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of bail.
