On 02/08/2014 at 02:31am Pine Hill Officers were dispatched by Camden County Central Communications to the 1000 block of Cranford Drive for the report of two suspicious males entering a residence. An anonymous caller had provided the information to 9-1-1 telecommunications. Upon the officers arrival on location, they heard banging coming from the inside the residence. Officers secured the perimeter of the residence and observed foot prints in the snow leading to the rear door leading to the kitchen and a sliding glass door leading to the family room. Both doors were locked and there were no signs of forced entry.

Officers continued to hear the banging coming from the residence and located addition foot prints in the snow leading to an open crawl space door. Officers from the Clementon Police Department arrived to assist in securing the perimeter while Officers ordered two suspects from the crawlspace of the residence. Nicholas Ferrara and Walter Bricker 2<sup>nd</sup>, both of the 1000 block of Turnersville Road, were taken into custody without incident. Burglary tools were recovered from the scene and it was determined the suspects were attempting to remove copper piping from the residence to scrap.
