On June 25th, 2013 at approximately 12:25pm, the Pine Hill Police Department was dispatched to the area of West Branch Avenue for a report of a white work van following a female. Responding units checked the area but they were unable to locate the female or the van.

The investigating Officer contacted the original caller by phone. The caller reported she observed a white van stopped in the south bound lane on West Branch Avenue talking to a teenage female. The van was described as a white “work” type van, similar to a Ford Econoline van. The caller assisted the female and the van left the area south bound on West Branch Avenue. The caller described the vehicle as a white van without any markings on it and black tinted rear windows. The caller reported the van had New Jersey license plates with a partial registration number containing “WG4”.

The thirteen year old female reported the van pulled up next to her and the male driver told her to get into the van. She reported the subject was a male of middle-eastern decent, approximately 40 years old. Anyone with information is asked to contact the Det.
