On Wednesday, May 29th, 2013 at approximately 6:18pm a Pine Hill Officer conducted a stop of two suspicious males in the area of the 200 building of the Mansions Apartment Complex. During the course of the pedestrian stop, Kelvin Williams was arrested on an active warrant issued out of the Deptford Twp. Municipal Court. Search of his person incident to arrest led to the seizure of 22 bags of suspected Crack Cocaine. \$357.79 was also seized from Mr. Williams. The suspect was processed accordingly and remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of cash bail.
