On November 15th, 2013 at approximately 10:51pm a Pine Hill Police Officer on a Directed Patrol in the Mansions Apartment complex observed a vehicle parked outside the 1400 building. Due to suspected suspicious activity of the vehicle occupants, the Officer conducted a motor vehicle stop with the vehicle in the 500 block of Blackwood Road.

During the course of the motor vehicle stop and subsequent investigation a Pine Hill Police narcotic detection K9 was called to the scene to assist. During the assist, K9 Cliff alerted to the presence of a narcotic odor coming from the vehicle. Continued investigation led to a search of the vehicle and seizure of Marijuana and Crack Cocaine, both packaged consistent for distribution and a quantity of Crack Cocaine. It was determined at the scene the occupant of the vehicle, Rasul Dunlap, possessed the illegal narcotics. Dunlap also provided a false identity and resisted Officers attempted to secure him in a marked patrol unit. He was ultimately secured without injury to himself or the attesting Officers. A female in the vehicle, Amirah Cotton, was arrested for an outstanding traffic warrant out of Collingswood Municipal Court.
