INCIDENT:	Possession of defaced handgun by certain person not to possess. Possession of CDS w/ intent to distribute.	DATE/TIME:	10/30/2013 8:32pm

On Wednesday October 30th, 2013 at approximately 8:32pm a Pine Hill Officer assigned to a Directed Patrol in The Mansions Apartments approached three individuals loitering in the area of the 1000 building and immediately smelled the strong odor of Marijuana. Continued investigation led to the arrest of Dominic E. Monahan for possession of twenty-nine (29) narcotic pills. The suspect began struggling with the arresting Officer as he was being patted down. After a brief struggle, the suspected was controlled and a loaded .22 caliber handgun was seized from his pocket. The suspect was taken into custody without injury to the suspect or Officer involved. The serial number on the firearm was defaced and Monahan was determined to be a certain person not to possess a firearm due to a previous criminal conviction.

A second individual, Megan M. Pancrazio was arrested for possessing narcotic pills and three hypodermic needles; She was later found to be in possession of Heroin during a search conducted at the Camden County Correctional Facility.

Both individuals were processed accordingly and remanded to the Camden County Correctional facility in default of bail.
