

STATEMENT OF CIRCUMSTANCES:


On March 1st, 2014 Patrolman Kramer and Patrolman Rowello were working a directed patrol in the 200 block of W. Branch Avenue. At approximately 8:00pm a motor vehicle stop was conducted on West Branch Avenue for a moving violation. During the course of the motor vehicle stop and subsequent investigation, a quantity of crack cocaine estimated to weigh more than two ounces and packaged with consistent with distribution, an Oxycodone narcotic pill and \$738 dollars cash were seized.

The driver, Anita J. Creech of Gloucester City was arrested and later charged with Possession of ½ Ounce or more of Cocaine with Intent to Distribute, Possession of Cocaine w/Intent to Distribute within 500 feet of a Public Park, Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substance (Oxycodone) and a related traffic offense. She was remanded to the Camden County Correctional Facility in default of bail \$56,000 bail.


