- Email received from OIC of Lindenwold Police Department for Det. Field and Ptl. Heron assist during joint operation between Lindenwold, Clementon and Pine Hill Police Departments resulting in 13 arrests, significant leads into several on-going investigations and seizure of a handgun.


On January 14, 2012 at 0140 hours, our officers were dispatched to a report of a fight at the Roadhouse on Clements Bridge Road. While the officers were responding, the call was upgraded to a report that shots had been fired. Arriving officers were given a vehicle description that was reported to contain the shooter. This information was relayed immediately along with the fact that the direction of travel was Clements Bridge Road toward Runnemede.

Ptl. Harry Moore of Magnolia PD spotted a vehicle fitting the description at Schubert Avenue and Clements Bridge Road. He advised Central Communications and requested assistance. Once assisting officers arrived, a felony car stop was conducted at Clements Bridge Road and Second Avenue, Runnemede. The location of this stop is approx. 1 mile from the Roadhouse.

This car was in fact occupied by the shooter and was fleeing the scene. A total of 7 shots had been fired at the victim who was hit three times. To date, the 9 mm. handgun used in this crime has not been recovered.

K-9 Officer Chris Witts was requested to assist checking the crime scene for the gun used by the shooter. They did an extensive search of the area, but were unsuccessful. Not only is Ptl. Witts to be commended for his excellent police work; but I also wanted to thank him. He is truly a credit to the Pine Hill Police Department and the willingness to provide mutual aid is greatly appreciated.

Once the five subjects in the car were secured and brought to our station, officers assisted in standing guard over them. One concern was to prevent the ability of communication by hand signals until we could sort out what happened. Thank you for the close working relationship and friendship enjoyed by our police departments over the years. This is another fine example of a job well done.

I am writing to express my sincere gratitude to two of your employees; Det. John Field and Ptlm. Bill Herron. As you know, on January 19, 2012 this department conducted an operation into street crimes occurring along Gibbsboro Road and Blackwood Clementon Road. We were assisted by your department, and members of the Clementon Police Department and the Camden County Prosecutor's Office. Det. Field and Ptlm. Herron assisted Lindenwold officers with serving warrants, conducting surveillance on known narcotics locations, and gathering intelligence on known and suspected gang members. The detail resulted in 13 arrests, and generated leads into several active investigations including an armed robbery and a shooting.
